We are sharing the weekly update of the key ongoing projects.

Sankalp Project:

Purpose:

To certify the people employed directly or indirectly by Gram Panchayat for their Prior Learning Experience under the RPL program in Varanasi and Chandauli.

Target Group:

Fundamentally this program is made to serve the purpose of Certifying people who are employed by Gram Panchayat on a full-time or job work basis.

The certified candidates will get all the benefits under RPL in addition to Upskilling Training i.e. Government Certificate, Kit, Insurance, etc.

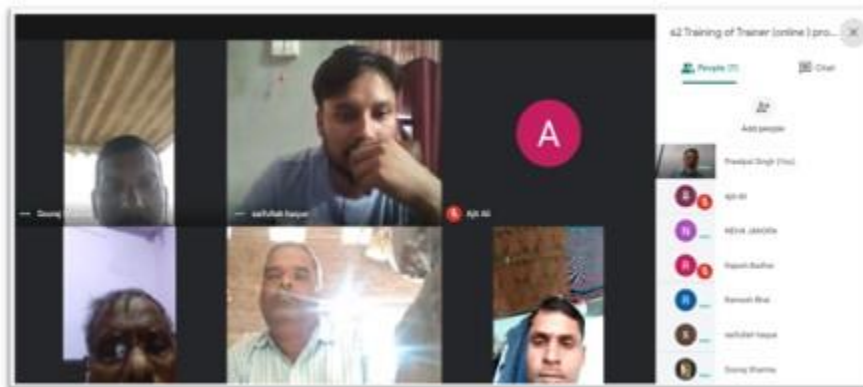
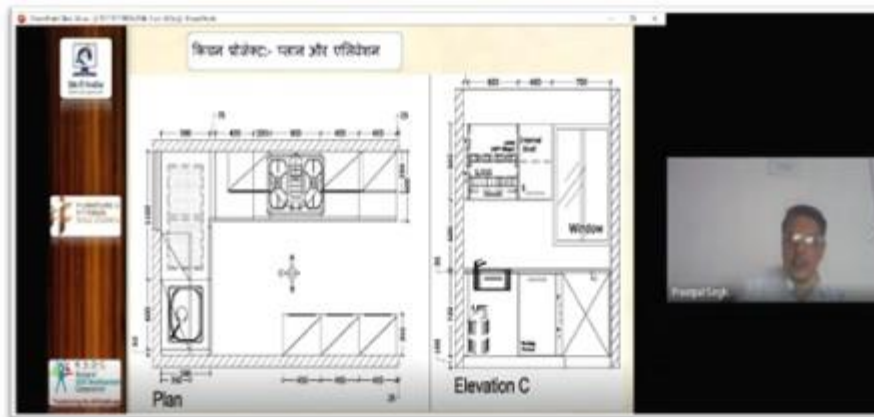
FFSC has been allotted **1000 numbers** to conduct **42 hours RPL Bridge program** in the 2 districts of **Varanasi and Chandauli**.

Till date, FFSC has been able to complete the training of **263 candidates** together in Sewapauri (Varanasi) and in Niamtabad (Chandauli).



ToT / ToA Sessions:

FFSC has started the Training of the Trainers / Assessors session online where the Master Trainer imparts the domain and platform training component through video conferencing. The practical sessions are demonstrated by the participating trainers online at their nearest woodworking workshop.



Two Training of the Trainer (ToT) sessions were held in Lead and Assistant Carpenter job roles from 5th – 14th October 2020 and from 2nd – 11th November 2020.

A total of **28 trainers** participated in the two ToT sessions.

One Training of the Assessors (ToA) session is being held for Lead and Assistant Carpenter job roles from 23rd – 29th November 2020.

A total of **18 assessors** are participating in the ongoing ToA session.

NSKFDC Workshops

Purpose:

National Safai Karmacharis and Finance Development Corporation (NSKFDC) functioning under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE) is organizing half-day workshops on “**Prevention of hazardous cleaning of sewers and septic tanks**” during the year 2020-21 in various municipalities through Furniture & Fittings Skill Council.

Target Group:

The program aims to aware participants of the elimination of manual scavenging and the safety of the workers engaging in the cleaning of septic tanks and sewers to prevent the death of such workers while performing the job.

In these workshops’ officers, engineers, sanitary inspectors, contractors, etc. along with the Safai Karmacharis attend the workshops.

- Provision of MS Act 2013, and MS Rules regarding safe and healthy cleaning of sewers and septic tanks.
- Precautions to be taken before, during, and after cleaning of sewers and septic tanks safety guards, equipment and machines to be used
- Schemes for financing sanitation and other rehabilitation related projects are a few of the major points of discussion of the workshop.

In this connection, FFSC has to organize **60 workshops in different states** (Gujarat, Bihar, Jharkhand, Jammu & Kashmir) of India.

Till date, FFSC has organized **34 workshops in different municipalities.**
