Furniture and Fittings Skill Council (FFSC) restarted the training programs following the guidelines issued by MOHFW and MSDE. We are sharing the weekly update of the key ongoing projects.

### **‘The Apprenticeship Advantage’ Workshops:**

FFSC has initiated a series of monthly workshops for industry partners to create awareness regarding the benefits of apprenticeship and operational framework. The workshops aim to provide the industry partners and their HR teams a unique opportunity to learn about the new **Apprenticeship Framework** and onboarding process through the Apprenticeship Portal.



The 3rd workshop in the series of ‘The Apprenticeship Advantage’ workshops was held on 27th November 2020 with participation from **HR teams of Industry Partners**. Representatives from NSDC’s Apprenticeship Division, Narsi Group and team FFSC made key presentations in the workshop.

## Skill Ambassador Campaign: Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

FFSC restarted the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) training under Skill Ambassador Campaign (SAC) following the guidelines issued by MOHFW and MSDE.

FFSC sessions are ongoing in Munger, Bihar for **Assistant and Lead Carpenters** with special sessions from Industry and Academic experts who attend online via video conferencing.

FFSC Team takes the **orientation session** for the candidates by covering the introduction of the skilling ecosystem, COVID-19 protocols to be followed, soft skills, details of the PMKVY scheme its benefits and opportunities through RPL certification.



Industry experts participate in the domain training sessions to take specific modules for the candidates and clear their queries.

Experts from **Hettich India and Narsi Group** have taken the sessions and informed the candidates about technical modules like hinges/fittings, the industry scenario, international standards and opportunities for the workforce in the sector.
